Open the talech app and enter your credentials which were sent in your talech welcome email to log onto talech.com/login to perform any bulk actions needed.



Setting up Hardware

STEP 1:

iPad®, iPad Air® (pre-installed) and iPad Air 2® trays are available and labeled in the box. Select your iPad, iPad Air and iPad Air 2 versions for proper use.

STEP 2:

To install the iPad or iPad Air tray, remove the four pre-installed mounting screws to swap mounting trays, if required.

STEP 3:

Ensure the Lightning® connector cap is pulled out before installing the iPad.



STEP 4:

Install the iPad by inserting the top side first and then Lightning connector side.

STEP 5:

Press the Lightning connector plug into the tray and fasten locking screw if desired.

STEP 6:

To eject the iPad from the dock, pull the Lightning connector cap out first and then press the eject button to remove your device from the dock.
